Summary of Issue: Authorization by the following resolution is requested to make final payment to Tri City Paving in the amount of \$62,396.20 for bituminous paving at the Aitkin Shop facility, bituminous paving on County Highways 54, 66, 77, 82, 83, and 85 and bituminous patches on County Highways 8, 14, 16, 24, and 40, all under Contract No. 20131. The final contract amount of \$1,247,923.89 is approximately 3.7% higher than the bid amount of \$1,174,255.10. The cost overrun was primarily due to adjusting the pavement thickness on CR 85 from the planned 1.5-inch thickness to a 2.5-inch thickness due to the excessively thin existing pavement thickness. Resolution: WHEREAS, Contract No. 20131 has in all been completed, and the County Board being fully advised in the premises. NOW THEN BE IT RESOLVED, That the Aitkin County Board of Commissioners does hereby accept said completed project for and on behalf of the County of Aitkin and authorize final payment to Tri City Paving in the amount of \$62,396.20.
