

Motion carried, Napstad/Marcotte, to approve the September 22, 2015 amended agenda. Item 2H on the consent agenda, Adopt Resolution - Set Date for County Tax-Forfeited Land Sale was amended to add one additional parcel (#28) and Request to Approve Bid to Re-roof Health & Human Services Building, was added to the agenda
Motion carried, Napstad/Niemi, to approve the amended consent agenda
To approve September 8, 2015 County Board minutes
To adopt Resolution - 2015-2017 Off-Highway Vehicle Safety Enforcement
