Dear Director Kelly:

Based upon supporting documents provided to me by the Department of Public Safety-Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, I have determined that damage in certain areas of Aitkin, Benton, Carlton, Crow Wing, Kanabec, Meeker, Mille Lacs, Morrison, Pine, and Traverse counties resulting from severe thunderstorms, high winds, tornadoes, and flooding during the period July 9-11, 2016, is of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant the use of the State Public Disaster Assistance fund, as described under Minn. Stat. §12B.

In order to provide state public disaster assistance, I hereby designate you as my authorized representative so that you may:

- allocate such amounts as you find necessary for state disaster assistance from funds available for these purposes;
- provide public assistance in the designated area; and
- provide additional assistance if requested by a local government; and warranted by the results of further damage assessments, to the extent allowable under Minn. Stat. §12B.

From: Sheriff Scott Turner      Re: Storms of July 9 -11, 2016 and July 21, 2016

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Letters were recently sent to Governor Mark Dayton requesting public damage assistance for the affected local units of government, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 12B, for both the rain/flood event of July 9-11, 2016 and for the windstorm event of July 21, 2016.

On August 17<sup>th</sup> Aitkin County Emergency Management facilitated a meeting between the local public entities and the Minnesota Department of Public Safety - Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. The preliminary damage amount for Aitkin County and the 18 affected townships (Aitkin, Beaver, Clark, Farm Island, Glen, Hazelton, Jevne, Kimberly, Lakeside, Malmo, Morrison, Nordland, Salo, Spencer, Turner, Wagner, Williams, and Workman) was \$727,680.00. Yesterday, I received notification from HSEM Director Joe Kelly that he had recommended Aitkin County for disaster assistance for July 9-11 event.

Another letter was sent requesting similar assistance for the windstorm event. Following that August 17<sup>th</sup> meeting, the total damages associated with that event for Aitkin County, City of Hill City and the townships of Hill Lake, Turner and Workman was \$132,850.
