Treatment Coordination Services

1. Receive Treatment Coordination Services:

• If you are interested in receiving Treatment Coordination Services, please contact Health & Human Services at 218-927-7200 and ask for Adult Intake to discuss the program.

2. Treatment Coordination includes:

- a. Assistance in coordination with significant others to help in the treatment planning process.
- b. Assistance in coordination with and follow-up for medical services as identified in the treatment plan.
- c. Facilitation of referrals to substance use disorder services as indicated by the client's medical provider, comprehensive assessment, or treatment plan.
- d. Facilitation of referrals to mental health services as identified by a client's comprehensive assessment or treatment plan.
- e. Assistance with referrals to economic assistance, social services, housing resources, and prenatal care according to the client's needs.
- f. Live skills advocacy and support accessing treatment follow-up, disease management, and education services, including referral and linkages to long-term services and supports as needed.
